Olivia Henderson qualified for the championship division in her 1st year of playing competitive tennis.

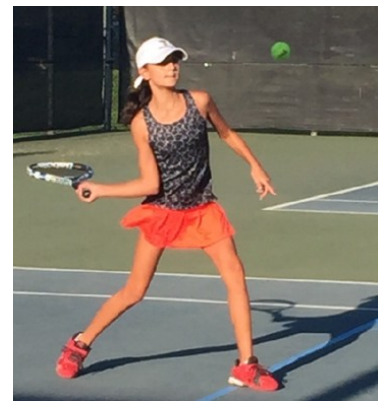

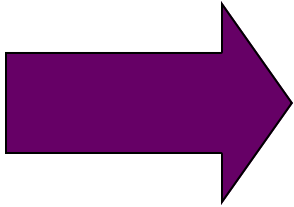
