In 2021, the Club will celebrate our Centennial Birthday. The Board is committed to making the next 100 years even better!

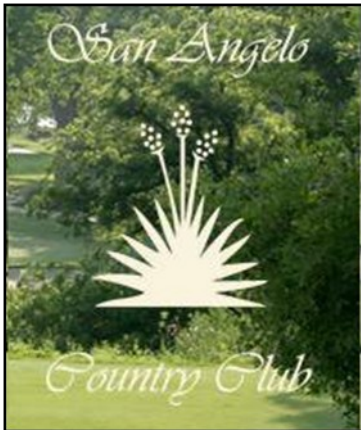

Aerification

AERIFICATION UPDATE

This year we are changing up our aerification program. Normally we use 3/8" tines in the spring with a heavy sand topdressing and follow that up with 1/4" tines right after partnership with little to no sand. We will punch holes three times this year: either March 27/28 or April 3/4, June 26/27 and September 11/12. Each time we will use the smaller 1/4" tines. By doing this there will be far less disruption to play in the spring but still remove the necessary thatch by adding a third aerification in the fall. It normally takes five or six weeks for the greens to completely recover in the Spring which everyone hates (including me). With this change, greens will be fairly smooth the next day and completely recovered in seven to ten days. The course will not have to be closed on the Tuesday. We will have to do more light topdressing, but this does not affect the playability of the course.

We will see how the greens respond to these changes and make any adjustments necessary next year. We will notify you as to the exact dates for the Spring aerification as the date gets closer.

Golf Etiquette

Keep the round moving by being prepared to hit your shot when it is your turn.

Do not spend too much time looking for a lost ball, particularly if there is a group behind you ready to play. If you insist on taking the full five minutes allotted to look for lost balls, golf etiquette says wave up the group behind to allow them to play through.

Always try to keep pace with the group ahead of you. If holes open in front of you, allow a faster group to play through.

When two players in a cart hit to opposite sides of a hole, drive to first ball and drop off that player with his club, then drive to the second ball. After both players hit, meet up farther down the hole.

When walking from your cart to your ball, take a couple clubs with you. Taking only one club, then having to return to the cart to select a different club, is a huge time-waster.
