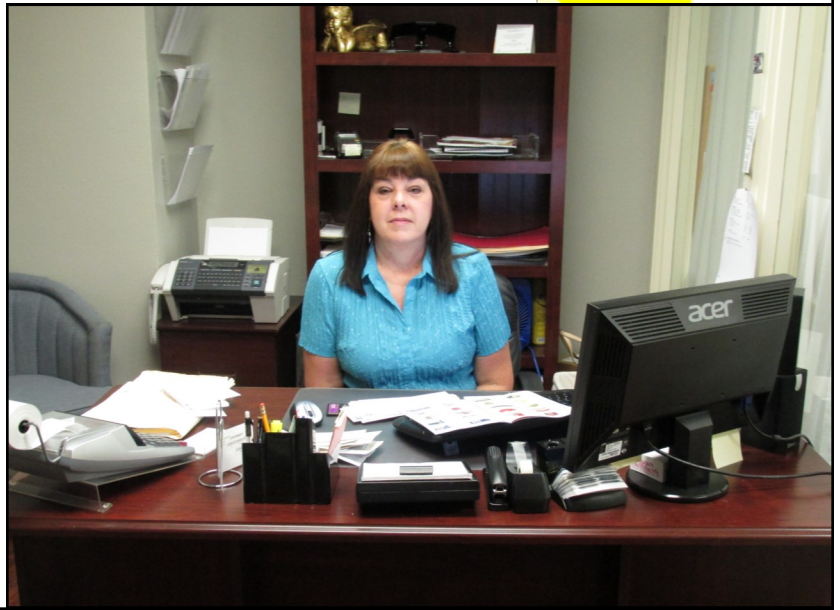

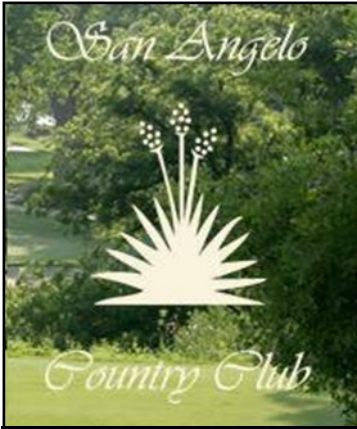

The grass is fully grown in around "Killer's Corner" making the renovations complete on hole 8 tee box.



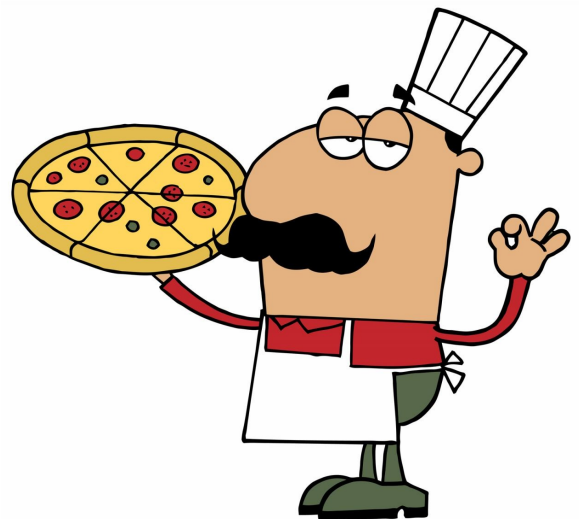
Family and friends joined together and updated the area in honor of Joe Kilman's 80th birthday!
