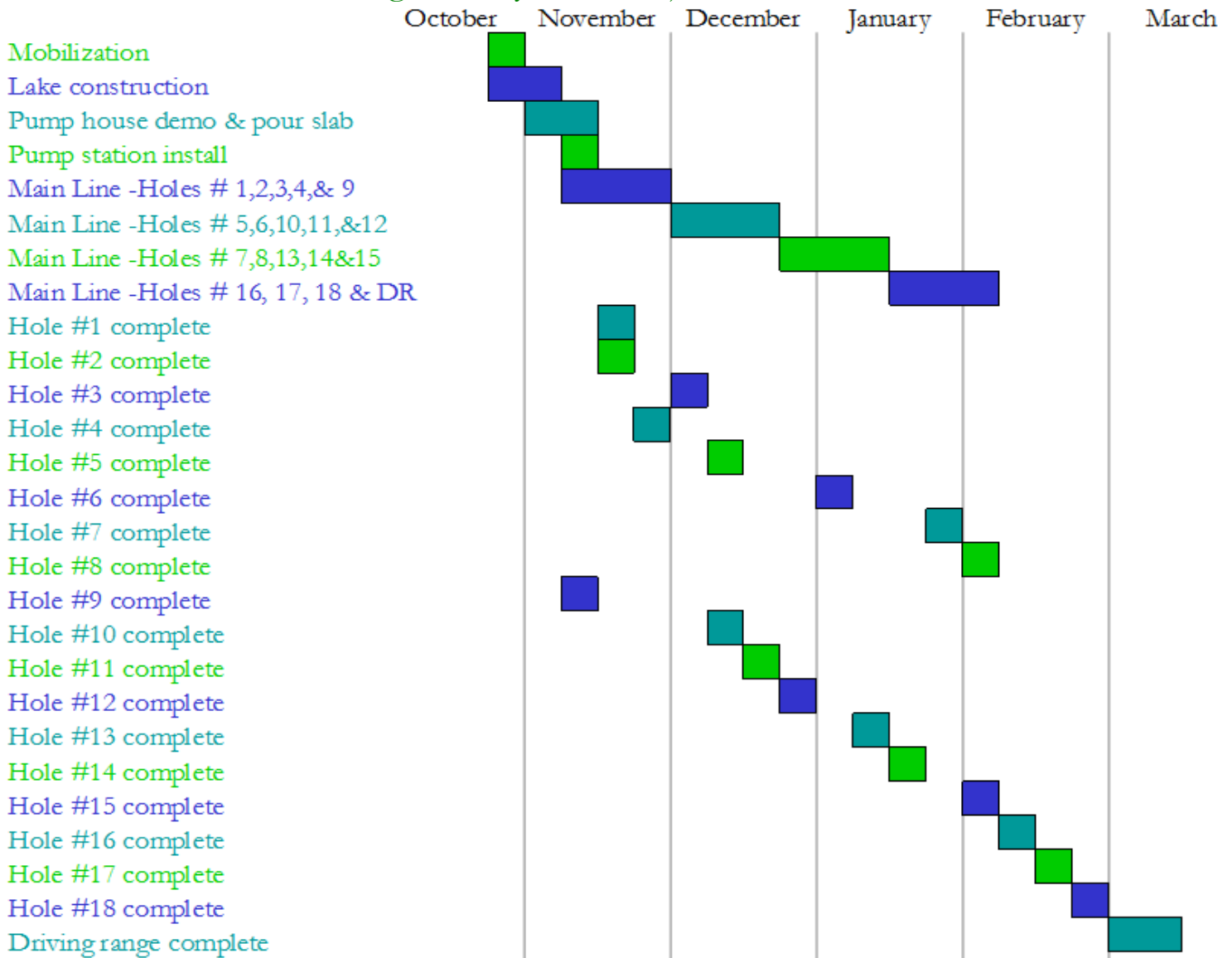

# At the Club...

## Irrigation System Projected Schedule



With the excitement of a new irrigation system being installed and the promise of the best course conditions in West Texas, we understand that there will be some inconveniences for our golfing membership during the construction process. During the weeks leading up to the beginning of construction, golfers will notice some changes to the course. There will be construction flags placed on the course in preparation of the installation, and it is important to the process that those flags are not disturbed. We ask that if you see these flags on the course to do your best not to drive over, move, or remove them.

During this process there will also be a great deal of stress on to the golf course, and in an effort to protect the integrity of the turf we ask that players observe the cart path only rule where possible. In doing so, we will ensure that the high traffic areas have minimal stress and will be able to recover quickly as the 2018 golfing season begins. As the installation progresses there will be unfortunate times where certain holes will have to be closed to play. We thank you for your understanding during this time and aim to cause as little disruption to play as possible. During these times we will be using the Rule 4-2 in the USGA Handicapping Manual, or "Par Plus" as it is commonly referred to. The procedure for using this method is to record *par* plus any handicap strokes the player is entitled to receive on that hole. Example: a player with a course handicap of 18 would take par plus 1 stroke as their score on each hole that is not played.
