## Tennis Tip:

### Attack on second serves!!!!

Most of my students are very familiar with the strategy of attacking short balls during singles rallies. We work on them constantly as a way of putting pressure on opponents and attempting to win points, rather than just wait for our opponents to make a mistake. We also work repeatedly on approach shots in doubles as a way of gaining a position advantage on the other team. My question is: Why would a weak serve be any different than a traditional short ball in singles or doubles? A weak serve just might be the shortest ball that you get the entire point. Attack it like you would any other short ball in the middle of a rally. In singles, you can go with an aggressive ground stroke or an approach and volley. In doubles, you can do the same or even go aggressively at the net person or down the line. By just putting the return in play and backing up, you are letting your opponent get away with a huge weakness. Make them pay for it and you will break serve more often.
